My apologies for this being a bit late but I only got back from the Canberra Yellowfin Tournament last night and was not in the mood for working out figures. It was a fantastic event with 106 boats and 23 clubs represented. Not a lot of fish however as the water was like a bath and just too hot for Yellowfin. The heaviest was 66.6kg captured by Chris Brash from Jervis Bay and there was a very nice Blue Marlin captured by Jason Sinclair from Ulladulla which weighed 210.2kg.

Anyway the leaders remain but the points have had a bit of a hit up with Merimbula obviously gaining from their tournament, as did Eden. Both events went off very well with a lot of happy anglers which is what it is all about. We all rely quite heavily on our tournaments for our financial viability and it is good to see them being supported.

The NSWGFA AGM is coming up in Merimbula in July. Nominations are being requested for the Executive. If anyone wants to nominate for Southern Zone Chairman I would be happy to relinquish the position. Please let me know so that we can get a nomination in on time. Remember that the Chairman cannot fish the NSW Interclub, as he/she has to work for the tournament over the ten days and he/she must attend a certain number of executive meetings in Port Stephens or Sydney. There is of course the point score to be calculated monthly and any disputes to be handled. It is not onerous but it is quite time consuming at times and certainly needs commitment.

Our AGM will be in June and I will let you know further details as I get them.
