The Mako issueIsn't it amazing what the power of a lost vote can do! The huge response from recreational game fishers with letters, emails and petitions really had an impact on Minister Garret and his cohorts. NSWGFA and Fisheries worked tirelessly, along with others to get this ridiculous ban overturned. The bottom line is that you can still tag and release them but only capture in sanctioned tournaments and NOT club competition. This agreement is in place until the end of March when we hope it will have gone through Parliament again. If it has not gone through then NSWGFA will submit a further draft so that it can be extended. Your clubs will have all received a copy of the email from NSWGFA explaining this a few weeks ago.

There have been mixed results from the recent tournaments and obviously there are some good fish being taken. A lot of tags have been used and there were a good number of points accumulated for various clubs. Things are getting tight with tag and release. This month we had seven boats with 10000 points and a number of others with less who did not make the cut.

The Interclub is coming up at the end of this month and I will be heading up there next week. It is good to see that we have a few boats from the Southern Zone competing and I wish them luck and will catch up there.

Just a reminder that the Zone weekends are now the 2nd and 4th for every month and that fish taken at the Interclub are counted in our Cock O the Walk Competition.

Another reminder to make sure that you put coordinates on your tag cards as well as a general location. Have had a few phone calls from Fisheries about this and some other anomalies so please take the time and fill them out correctly.

Your clubs will have also received an email from NSWGFA President Don Goswell re the calling in of weights for fish in tournaments. There have been some noticeable discrepancies in the reported estimated weight and the actual weight. This really is unfair on the other competitors and needs to be addressed.

Have included the entry form for the Southern Zone Interclub and you will note that anglers can fish out of their own ports. Please put this on your web sites and encourage your members to participate. Entry forms will also be mailed to each club. Hopefully with this change in format we will get a decent number of competitors. The dinner will again be at Batemans Bay and catered for by Gail who does such an amazing job. Hope to see a lot of you there.
