The final results were hotly contested with 'Profishent' from Kiama taking out the major prize for boats over 7.5 meters and "Side Effect" from Ulladulla taking the category for boats under 7.5 meters.

Isn't it great to see so many boats out there amongst the fish, both capture and tagging. And that is only the top five from our clubs listed! I know that there have been a lot more than shown on our records as many fish have been taken on non Zone days and also boats that did not make the top five on their club return. So well done everyone!

The NSWGFA Interclub is next on my list and I know there are a number of SZ boats fishing which is great. The Southern Zone Interclub is the same weekend as the Alliance out of Bermagui so you can fish both for a nominal fee.
