Our AGM was interesting with quite a few issues discussed and debated including the motions put forward for the NSWGFA AGM.

One of the issues that is of great concern to NSWGFA is the use of electronic media and some of the inappropriate photos that are being put up on club websites. If these websites were only available to members this may not be such a problem but as they are not it is really stupid to give fuel to our protagonists. NSWGFA has a very strict Media Policy and I think some people are certainly in breach of this.

It was interesting to hear from the Merimbula guys who had a meeting with BOM and there seems to be a move in the right direction. BOM are apparently change the boundaries on their maps so that the areas are not so large. For example it will be Ulladulla to Montague and Montague to Gabo instead of all in one hit. This will help when we have gale warnings. They are also going to change the format of reporting so that when a gale warning is declared it will be closer to the actual time and not at 4.30am. We have all had tournaments cancelled because of a warning only to have perfect weather so this has got to be an improvement. I believe this will commence around September.

On the Mako shark issue, Pat has sent out another email to all clubs confirming that we can still only take Makos at recognised sanctioned game fishing tournaments. Once the amendment becomes law all will be advised. The original notice went out 22 June so please ensure that all your members are aware.

Batemans Bay have got off to a good start with results from their Yellowfin Tournament and there are a few of you out there tagging. Lets hope that the season ahead is a good one and you all get amongst the fish.

I look forward to working with you all for another year and am still waiting for some tournament dates for the calendar. Invoices will be sent out for delegate fees and penalties next week.
