I would have thought that by now you would all know how to fill in a card but obviously that is not the case. If there is important information missing then these cards should not be sent to Fisheries and they certainly will not be counted for end of year trophy categories. We are not the only ones to be doing this but our Zone certainly is getting its fair share and I am continually being hauled over the coals about it.

It is also important to send your cards to Fisheries on a regular basis and not keep them for months or more. This is really important as some of the GFAA trophies are tabulated from these cards returned to Fisheries.

The tournament season is well and truly getting under way. Shoalhaven Light Tackle has just been held and Jervis Bay White Sands Tournament is in a couple of weeks. The calendar is pretty full from then on so I expect to get a few more points up for all clubs participating.

Hopefully we will have good representation at the Southern Zone meeting scheduled for next Friday 19 November 2010 at the Catalina Club, Batemans Bay at 7pm. There are a few issues that need to be discussed and we also have to make plans for our Interclub.
