From the DPI Newsletter : Of interest is the recapture of a Yellowfin released by "Shockwave" from Eden GFC in February 2011. It had grown an estimated 6kg to approximately 20kg after being at liberty for over 15 months. It was taken by a longliner fishing wide off Tuross this winter. Another was an estimated 50kg Mako released by "Reel Shattered" from Jervis Bay in November 2011 and recaptured by a longliner at Bellona Reefs in the Coral Sea. It had been at liberty for over six months and had covered a straight line distance of 893NM.

It would appear that the shark fishers are at least having some luck. Apparently there are Yellowfin off Sydney so hopefully they will start to come down soon along with some Marlin. Shellharbour has a good lead at the moment so it will be interesting to see how things progress as the season hots up. Tight lines everyone!

Next month sees the Shoalhaven Light Tackle Tournament as well as the Jervis Bay White Sands Tournament. Do make an effort and support these tournaments if you can. I know your participation is appreciated and these events are always a great opportunity to catch up with friends and share fishing experiences whether good or bad.
